

DIRECTIONS

GETTING THERE

It can be a little difficult finding my extremely humble office because the entrance is not in King Street itself, but 10 metres up Argyle Place, on the right. Please ring the bottom bell. Any problems, telephone and I'll come out and find you.

Argyle Place, about five minutes from Hammersmith tube, is the fourth turning on the right, approximately half way between the King Street shopping centre and Hammersmith Town Hall. It is after the Argos catalogue shop, and before the Holiday Inn Hotel.

Buses along King Street are: 27, 267, 391. Get off at the second or third stop.

Hammersmith in West London is about 20 minutes from Piccadilly Circus and about 40 minutes from Heathrow. There are three tube lines: Piccadilly, District (Richmond and Ealing Broadway lines - be careful NOT to board a Wimbledon train) and the Hammersmith and City Line. There are numerous bus services to Hammersmith bus station.

Parking can be a problem, except on Sunday and after six in the evening.
